### KURE TAISHOMACHI ICHIBA MARKET

Kure Taishomachi Ichiba is a local market since around 1880. Kure area is known as a fisherman's town for more than 400 years. And it is famous for Bonito(Katsuo) fish. Fishermen here hook bonito one by one. If they used nets they could catch much more fish, but they don't use nets. Because using nets would damage fishes and they know the damaged fish is not the best for Sashimi. Japanese people love eating Sashimi. Especially in Kure, fisherman's town people have good taste for fish. We are proud of the quality of the fresh fish!

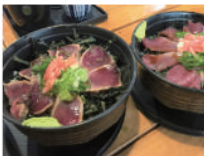

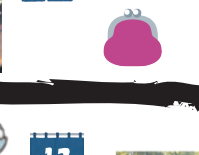

Old fish shop older than 100 years. Several kinds of fresh seasonal fish line up here.

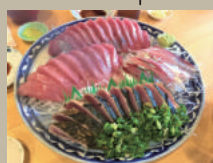

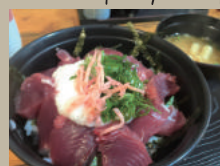
